

18 scheduled destinations served by 6 airlines

International traffic doubled compared to Summer 2024

Salerno, April 8, 2025 - The Salerno-Amalfi Coast Airport, inaugurated on July 11 last year, celebrates its first summer season with an extensive flight offering strongly oriented toward the international market.

The Summer 2025 season, which began on March 30 with the new connection to Vienna, continued on April 4 with the introduction of the route to Brussels Charleroi. The offering will gradually expand to reach a total of **18 scheduled destinations** during the summer period. Of these, 13 are international: Barcelona, Berlin, Brussels Charleroi, Bucharest, Geneva, Lyon, London Gatwick, London Stansted, Marseille, Nantes, Paris Orly, Tirana, and Vienna.

With **13 international routes** compared to 7 operated last summer, Salerno, less than a year after opening, has nearly **doubled its international traffic**, with connections to 7 European capitals (Berlin, Brussels, Bucharest, London, Paris, Tirana, Vienna).

The number of airlines operating in Salerno also shows a quality increase, thanks to the entry of British Airways, which, starting from May 22, will offer 3 weekly frequencies to London Gatwick, and Vueling, which will connect Salerno with Paris and Barcelona starting from June 20 and July 3, respectively. This brings to 6 the number of carriers offering direct connections: **British Airways**, the British flag carrier, and the main European low-cost airlines **easyJet, Ryanair, Volotea, Vueling, and Wizz Air**.

"This is an extraordinary result for an airport that has been operational for less than a year. Our reputation represents a strategic advantage that allows us to serve as a valuable link with airlines, thanks to the integrated management of the Naples and Salerno airports," stated **Roberto Barbieri, CEO of GESAC**. "The significant expansion of the network, combined with targeted territorial marketing strategies and improved accessibility to the airport, will lead to an increase in passenger traffic, giving a strong boost to the entire regional tourism sector and opening new development prospects for high-quality destinations still little known in international markets."
