### **Aeroitalia and GESAC sign a strategic partnership for the development of Salerno Costa d'Amalfi and Cilento Airport**

*New direct flights to Genoa, Milan Malpensa, Turin and Trieste from the gateway to Cilento and the Amalfi Coast*

**Salerno, 20 February 2026** – Aeroitalia and GESAC announce the launch of an important partnership agreement aimed at strengthening and diversifying the range of air connections from Salerno Costa d'Amalfi and Cilento Airport, a privileged gateway to Cilento and the whole of Campania. The agreement is designed to respond concretely to the mobility needs of residents, businesses and tourists, promoting regional growth and enhancing its potential as a destination of tourism excellence.

#### **The new routes**

The program includes the basing of one aircraft and the launch of 19 weekly frequencies: direct connections to Genoa, Milan Malpensa, Turin and Trieste. All flights will be operated with comfortable 100-seat Embraer 190 aircraft, starting from 22 May, with fares from €39.99.

Below are the frequency details:

#### **Salerno ↔ Milan Malpensa**

- Departures from Salerno: Monday to Friday twice daily, at 07:10 and 18:00
- Returns from Milan Malpensa: Monday to Friday twice daily, at 09:30 and 20:20
- Saturday: departure from Salerno at 07:10, return from Milan Malpensa at 09:30
- Sunday: departure from Salerno at 18:00, return from Milan Malpensa at 20:20

#### **Salerno ↔ Genoa**

- Departures from Salerno: Thursday and Sunday at 13:10
- Returns from Genoa: Thursday and Sunday at 15:30

#### **Salerno ↔ Trieste**

- Departures from Salerno: Tuesday and Saturday at 13:10
- Returns from Trieste: Tuesday and Saturday at 15:30

#### **Salerno ↔ Turin**

- Departures from Salerno: Monday, Wednesday and Friday at 12:50
- Returns from Turin: Monday, Wednesday and Friday at 15:20

“Thanks to intensive teamwork with a partner that believes in the airport’s growth potential, we have restored momentum to Salerno Airport, creating the conditions for a stable resumption of scheduled flights, with a strong business focus,” said **Roberto Barbieri, Chief Executive Officer of GESAC**. “At the same time, we are building a favorable environment for the development of inbound tourism, promoting—together with institutional and business stakeholders, particularly the Salerno Chamber of Commerce—a territorial marketing strategy aimed at enhancing the destination in international tourism markets. Constructive dialogue with the Institutions continues in order to accelerate the strengthening of connections and access infrastructure and to initiate the process aimed at abolishing the municipal surcharge, a measure already successfully adopted in several Italian airports with fewer than one million passengers per year, and decisive in strengthening the attractiveness and competitiveness of Campania’s second airport.”
